winning short film about Deer Hollow Farm "*Lessons of the Land.*" The Farm's new Nature Center and the Friends booth will be open. Friends will have available for sale: T-shirts, plant and animal ID cards, bird houses, photo note cards, mugs, water bottles, hand-embroidered sweatshirts, and *The Grant Family History* booklet.
